Not to get ahead of myself but I am very excited for what we have coming up at Parkview over the next two months. You might remember, at the beginning of the year I outlined the flow of the first part of 2021, at least as I have planned it. We began with a focus on the spiritual disciplines, the essential building blocks for discipleship in the life of anyone seeking to follow after Christ. We then moved into our current series in the Gospel of Mark. We have been examining the life of Christ with a special focus on the kingdom of God He proclaimed and the call to follow after Him. MY instinct when I began thinking about the first half of 2021 was more of a focus on restoration and return. Everyone is making their way back. We're finally returning to "normal"! But very clearly, and I'll discuss this more later, around the end of November the Spirit expressed that 2021 was not meant to be a reunion year where we all squeeze in for a group hug and settle back into our comfortable normals. God is calling us out. The world around us is changing more quickly than it ever has in so many different ways. But THIS hasn't changed: people need Jesus.

And so even though it may feel counterintuitive to our desires and wisdom, 2021, the year we return to the building will be the year more than any other we focus on leaving the building. I hope you'll be there with us.


