Pray that God will prepare this man and his family, even now, for ministry at Parkview.

Pray that the one God calls to fill this position hears His voice clearly and acts without hesitation or excuse.

Pray for God's Holy Spirit to work in you. To purify you of any self-centeredness and to mold you into the image-bearing creation he created you to be.

Pray, as in Acts 4, that God will fill each of us with boldness, and that this giving of boldness will be accompanied by the miraculous acts and wonders of a faithful and mighty God.
