## “(Your Name Here), Do You Love Me?”

After Peter denies Jesus three times, Jesus restores Peter to ministry by asking him three times, “Peter, do you love me?” It’s a moment that epitomizes the mercy and forgiveness of Jesus. But it’s also a moment that we ought to apply to ourselves. Press yourself up against that story. Take Peter’s name out of the question and replace it with your own. “Joseph, do you love me?” “Joseph, do you love Jesus?” This is the most important question that we can ever ask of ourselves and answer.

Authentic Christianity is defined by supreme love for Christ. To be a Christian is to be born again. To have the old person go away and to be made a new creation. And this new creation has had its old heart of stone replaced with a heart that is defined by love. Love for God and others. And in the New Testament saving faith and love for Christ is synonymous. Consider these passages:

Luke 7:47—Whoever is forgiven much, loves much. (This means if your sins are forgiven you will love Christ much.)

Romans 8:28—God causes all things to work together for good, for those who love him and are called according to his purpose. (Everyone who is called into fellowship with Christ by God is identified by their love for God.)

1 Cor. 2:9—Eyes haven’t seen, ears haven’t heard, nor has it entered into the heart of man what God has prepared for those who love him. (Heaven is a place for only those who love Christ.)

1 Cor. 8:3—Whoever loves God, knows God. (Only those who love God, know God.)

1 Cor. 16:22—If anyone does not love the Lord he is to be accursed. (To not love Christ is to be condemned, to be damned.)

Eph. 6:24—Grace be to all those who love our Lord Jesus Christ with incorruptible love. (God’s grace is only extended to those who love Christ.)

We could go on, but I think the point is made. Those who have saving faith will respond with love for Christ. Love for Christ is evidence that a person is saved. So, I can know I’m saved if I love Jesus. But how do I know if I love Jesus? Well, thankfully Jesus answered that question for us. “If you love me you will obey my commandments.” (John 14:15) If you’re saved, you’ll love. If you love, you’ll obey. So, let’s examine ourselves, and ask the most important question we can, “(Your Name Here), do you love Jesus?”

## SUMMER CAMP 2024 NEWS



**Grades:** Sessions are determined by what grade a camper WILL BE GOING INTO for the fall. A camper may move DOWN one grade, but never UP a grade. An upcoming 6th grader may attend PreTeen Camp (down a grade), but an upcoming 8th grader may NOT attend Senior High camp (up a grade).

**Two Camps:** Campers may NOT register for more than one session as a camper.

1-An upcoming **6th grader** should NOT attend both PreTeen camp as a 5th grader and then Middle School camp as a 6th grader. They must choose ONE.

2-Same for upcoming **9th graders**; they should NOT attend High School camp as a 9th grader and then Middle School camp as an 8th grader. They must choose ONE.

Students in **3rd grade** should determine which camp fits them best (1 night or 3 nights).
