Last week I, like many of you, watched the eclipse. And I must tell you, the event wasn't congruent with the buildup. In fact, I jokingly texted my wife and children my review: "3 of 5 stars. Would not recommend." Of course, here in Chickasha I didn't experience "totality." But then I saw Steve's picture from Southeastern Oklahoma, and I got it. A total eclipse is clearly quite a thing. It's a testament to just how finely tuned, not just the moon and stars are, but the universe. It draws us into a place of wonder as we think about our creator. I don't use this word to describe many things, but it's "delightful."

But do you know who else delights in creation? Our Creator.

Psalm 104:31 says this, "May the glory of the Lord endure forever; *may the Lord rejoice in his works*." Now, that English word "may" might trip us up a bit if we're not careful. Because we might interpret that to mean that the Lord rejoicing in His works is merely a possibility. But we know that can't be true because that would then mean that the truth of the first line, the Lord's glory enduring forever, is merely a possibility. And all of Scripture tells us that God's glory enduring forever is not a possibility but a certainty. So, it's certain that God rejoices and delights in his creation.

The question, then, is "why?" Let me give you a few answers:

Psalm 19:1—Creation declares His glory.

Psalm 148 & Romans 8:22—Creation praises God and groans for redemption.

Psalm 104:24—Creation reveals His wisdom.

Isaiah 40:26—Creation reveals His power.

Psalm 104:31-34—Creation points people past itself to God Himself.

So, what's the point of all this? Well, the most obvious answer might be that if God delights and rejoices in creation it might be a healthy and helpful thing for us as well. But, perhaps, most important, is that we never forget that we are creation. And if we're creation that means we ought to be declaring God's glory, praising Him, and yearning for redemption, making his wisdom and power known into all the world, and pointing our fellow creatures toward the glory of the creator Himself, so that they too might delight and rejoice in Him as well.
