April will be a big month for us at Parkview. We of course have Resurrection Sunday to celebrate on April 20th. We're looking forward to a great celebration during the 10:30 worship service as well as our traditional Easter breakfast at 9 a.m. There will be no Sunday School that Sunday. We'll be organizing a group of men to prepare and serve breakfast that morning. If you're interested in being part of that, please let me know.

With that in mind, I'd like to encourage you to invite an unchurched friend or family with you to Parkview this Easter. Christmas and Easter are great opportunities to reach our unchurched friends because people tend to be more willing to attend on those Sundays. Don't miss this opportunity.

Another great opportunity for you and your family this Easter season will be our Good Friday Service, April 18th. Some of you may be familiar with the spiritual discipline known as the Stations of the Cross. If you are not, it is a Scriptural journey through the events of the final hours of Jesus life—praying in the garden, his betrayal and arrest, his trials, his scourging—that culminate in Jesus being crucified on the cross. Our Good Friday Service will be an interactive Stations of the Cross where participants will move from one station to the next, reflecting on Jesus's journey to the cross. It is a self-paced, self-led experience, of reflection, Scripture reading, prayer, and communion. I truly believe you'll be blessed to join us for this service.

With the hope that we can accommodate more people this year, our Good Friday Service will be open 12-1 P.M. and again at 5:30-7 P.M. Although each one's experience will be different, I would plan on spending at least 30 minutes at the service. We are looking forward to seeing you all there.

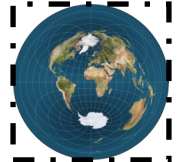

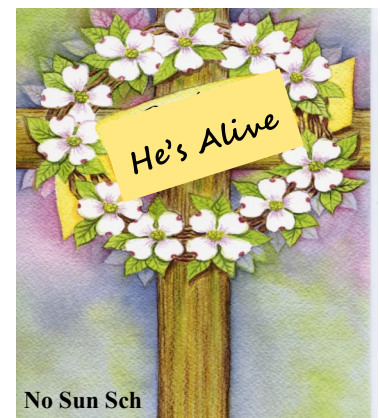

The Goal

The goal of Parkview Christian Church is to communicate the good news of Jesus Christ and to provide a positive environment in which all persons are encouraged to grow in their faith, love, and service to others. Parkview Christian Church has four goals we want to accomplish. The first is to reach the un-churched. The second is to disciple the believer. The third is to nurture the body of Christ, which is the church. The fourth goal is to equip others to serve.

The Work

Goals are helpful in recentring and focusing what you want to get done. Without a target, there's no telling why we do what we do, who we do it for, and to what end are we going. Without a plan on how to achieve the goals, the goals become an abstract ideal that we may or may not reach. It becomes something focused on at the beginning of the year or maybe focused on for a little while, but with no plan or revisit to the goals, they soon fade into the back of the fridge like the leftovers you planned on revisiting, but forgot about.

We have tried to focus in our preaching and teaching. We went through Conversational Evangelism as a church with the adults and students. Joseph taught on Acts. I made discussion around the ministry of Paul when relevant in Philippians. When it comes to service, Joseph has preached on the topic and I have been teaching on it since January with Philippians. When it comes to discipleship we have made the extra effort to have a men's fellowship (the woman do a fantastic job in fellowship). For a handful of people, there is a discipleship group (led by Tim and Tina) that we plan on being able to teach and have for future discipleship groups. We have been hosting prayer nights and worship nights to give glory to God and petition Him who created all things. For all of these things, I can promise you we will work to accomplish these goals. Not like a boxer beating the air, running the race aimlessly, but we are focused and training ourselves and others for the sake of receiving crowns that are imperishable.

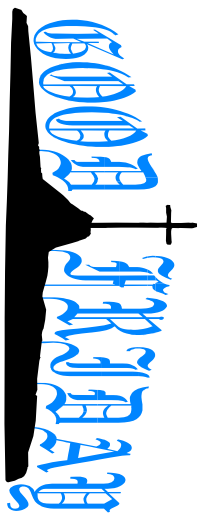
